

TOWN OF INGERSOLL NOTICE OF PASSING OF A DEVELOPMENT CHARGES BY-LAW

DEVELOPMENT CHARGES ACT, 1997, S.O. 1997, c.27

TAKE NOTICE that on July 14th, 2014, the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Ingersoll passed By-law 2014-4760 under Section 2 of the *Development Charges Act*, 1997, which imposes Town-wide development charge rates.

The charges in the aforementioned by-law will apply to all new residential development, subject to certain terms, conditions and limited exemptions as identified therein.

Development charges are levied against new development to pay for the increased capital costs related to the provision of such municipal services as general government, fire, parks and recreation, roads and related, and stormwater management services. Schedule 1 below sets out the development charge rates applicable throughout the Town.

The development charge rates will be in effect as of July 14th, 2014. Copies of the by-law can be viewed and downloaded at the Town of Ingersoll's website at www.ingersoll.ca. The complete development charges by-law can also be examined at the Town Clerk's Office from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday at the address shown below.

Any person or organization may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board in respect to the bylaw by filing with the Clerk of The Corporation of the Town of Ingersoll, not later than August 23rd, 2014, a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the by-law and the reasons in support of the objection.

Town-wide development charges apply to all lands located within the boundaries of the Town of Ingersoll. Map 1 delineates the "Central Business District and Entrepreneurial District" within which the aforementioned development charges do not apply.
